JANUARY

Ephesians 6:1-4 ~

- ¹ Children, obey your parents the way the Lord wants. This is the right thing to do.
- ² The command says, "Honor your father and mother." This is the first command that has a promise with it.
- ³ The promise is: "Then everything will be well with you, and you will have a long life on the earth."
- ⁴ Fathers, do not make your children angry, but raise them with the training and teaching of the Lord.

FEBRUARY

Psalms 1 ~

- ¹ Happy is the person who doesn't listen to the wicked. He doesn't go where sinners go. He doesn't do what bad people do.
- ² He loves the Lord's teachings. He thinks about those teachings day and night.
- ³ He is strong, like a tree planted by a river. It produces fruit in season. Its leaves don't die. Everything he does will succeed.
- ⁴ But wicked people are not like that. They are like useless chaff that the wind blows away.
- ⁵ So the wicked will not escape God's punishment. Sinners will not worship God with good people.
- ⁶ This is because the Lord protects good people. But the wicked will be destroyed.
