OCTOBER

Philippians 4:4-7 ~

- ⁴ Be full of joy in the Lord always. I will say again, be full of joy.
- Let all men see that you are gentle and kind. The Lord is coming soon.
- Do not worry about anything. But pray and ask God for everything you need. And when you pray, always give thanks.
- And God's peace will keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. The peace that God gives is so great that we cannot understand it.

NOVEMBER ~ I CORINTHIANS 13:1-7 ~ (PART 1 OF 2)

- I may speak in different languages of men or even angels. But if I do not have love, then I am only a noisy bell or a ringing cymbal.
- I may have the gift of prophecy; I may understand all the secret things of God and all knowledge; and I may have faith so great that I can move mountains. But even with all these things, if I do not have love, then I am nothing.
- I may give everything I have to feed the poor. And I may even give my body as an offering to be burned. But I gain nothing by doing these things if I do not have love.
- Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous, it does not brag, and it is not proud.
- ⁵ Love is not rude, is not selfish, and does not become angry easily. Love does not remember wrongs done against it.
- Love takes no pleasure in evil, but rejoices over the truth.
- ⁷ Love patiently accepts all things. It always trusts, always hopes, and always continues strong.

DECEMBER ~ I Corinthians 13:8-13 ~ (Part 2 of 2)

- Love never ends. There are gifts of prophecy, but they will be ended. There are gifts of speaking in different languages, but those gifts will end. There is the gift of knowledge, but it will be ended.
- These things will end, because this knowledge and these prophecies we have are not complete.
- But when perfection comes, the things that are not complete will end.
- When I was a child, I talked like a child; I thought like a child; I made plans like a child. When I became a man, I stopped those childish ways.
- It is the same with us. Now we see as if we are looking into a dark mirror. But at that time, in the future, we shall see clearly. Now I know only a part. But at that time I will know fully, as God has known me.
- So these three things continue forever: faith, hope and love. And the greatest of these is love.

MARCH

- ✓ List 3 qualifications of an elder and reference Bible verses.
- ✓ List the functions of elders mentioned in Acts 20:17-36, <u>learn that scripture location</u>, and <u>be able to state three functions</u>. Remember that elders (also known as shepherds, bishops, or overseers) should "smell like the sheep" of their flock; in other words, be out among the members of the congregation to know what their needs are.
- ✓ List and <u>learn the scripture reference</u> for the qualifications for elders. List the qualifications for the position of elder, and **be able to state at least three** from memory.

(Note: The intention of this memory item is to help you think in depth about the leadership of the church and about the great responsibility that God has placed on elders. There is more than one Bible passage dealing with elders. Please <u>bring your personal Bible</u> with you so that we can discuss these passages together.)

APRIL

On notebook paper, write the following information and bring with you, in addition to learning the indicated material.

- ✓ <u>Name</u> five areas of responsibility that deacons have at Mayfair.
- ✓ List and **be able to state** the scripture locations that give the qualifications for the position of deacon.
- ✓ List the qualifications for deacons and **be able to state at least three** from memory.
- ✓ Make an appointment with a deacon (other than a relative) *after* you have learned some of the qualifications. Make a list of at least five meaningful questions to ask in your interview. Feel free to ask your parents for help in making the list. (Sample questions below.)
 - o How long have you been a deacon?
 - o In what ministries have you served as a deacon?
 - What are your responsibilities as a deacon at Mayfair?
 - What do you enjoy most about being a deacon?
 - How do you feel God has equipped you to serve as a deacon?
 - What is the importance of having deacons serve God's church?
