- 4. Can you think of a time when you felt scared, but God helped you feel safe?
- 5. How can we show faith in God, like Daniel, when we face hard choices or scary situations?

BIG IDEA: GOD PROTECTED DANIEL BECAUSE OF HIS FAITH. (HEB. 11:33)

DID YOU KNOW?

When Daniel was thrown into the lions' den, he wasn't a young man—he was actually projected to be in his early 80s! Even after a lifetime of faithfully serving God, Daniel continued to pray and trust the Lord no matter the cost. God's protection and power are always the same, whether we're 8 or 80!

SOMETHING TO NOTE:

Every possible effort was made to make Daniel forget the God of his people, including changing Daniel's own name and embracing Babylon's pagan culture. Instead, Daniel remained true to God throughout his years in Babylon.
